- V. Call to the Audience
 - i. David Herring: has essentially been a department of one for the last six years. Excited about the possibility of an electives department.
- VI. Discussion & Action Items
 - a. Action Item: Approval of Grant Request for sousaphone road cases from Mr. Marchant
 - i. Motion by: I. Bacalia
 - ii. Seconded by: I Barrios
 - iii. Discussion/Debate: large ask, but we have spent much less this year than typical
 - a. J. Marchant: the bigger the instrument, the more costly it is. This proposal has been in the works for many years. Still using sousaphones from 1981. Newer ones are taking damage due to poor cases. Ask is for 12 as that is the most we have ever marched.

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- b. I. Barrios how much do we currently have. approximately \$54000
- iv. Motion passes: 16 yes, 1 abstention (The vote to abstain was from an audience member)
- b. Action Item: Approval of Motion to amend the UHS policy document to include the restructuring of departments on a one-year trial to replace the CTE department with a more broadly defined Electives Department
 - i. Motion by: J. Bacalia
 - ii. Seconded by: K. Vatthauer
 - iii. Discussion/Debate: would house teachers of courses not eligible for science, math, social studies, or English credit. 1 year trial.
 - a. J. Marchant: Does this include fine arts? Fine arts teachers would have the option of joining on a case by case basis.
 - b. Instructional council is in support.
 - c. J. Bacalia: this is a need for appropriate representation.
 - iv. Motion passes: 15 yes and 1 no
- c. Action Item: Resolution of the Department Restructuring Motion i. Resolved, the University High School Council approves the amendment of the UHS Policy Document to reflect the language to enact a one-year trial of department restructuring to replace the Career and Technical Education department (CTE) with an Electives department.
 - i. Resolution passes unanimously
- d. Discussion Item: Request for updates from each stakeholder group about elections for the school council members for the 2021-2022 school year.
 - i. L. Schuneman: 2 pledges to serve for 6 at large seats so far
 - ii. J. Ollanik: working on interest form. candidates will need to interview.
 - iii. B. Holtzman: vote at next meeting
 - iv. no UHSFAA members present
