

Proposed course description for Applied Sustainability:

Section VI.KK. – Applied Sustainability

VI.KK.1. An elective course open to grades 9-12.

VI.KK.2. Course can be taken as a one-semester or full-year course. Each semester earns one-half (0.5) General Elective credits upon successful completion.

VI.KK.3. In the Applied Sustainability class, students will build knowledge and skills in a variety of sustainable systems management and design fields. Systems investigated include agriculture, water, waste, built environment, energy, and materials. This course will provide students with authentic opportunities to integrate and apply knowledge from this and other science courses, within a sustainability context.
