- The Midwest Clinic began in 1946 with 160 band directors in a YMCA gymnasium as a music reading session
- It has grown into the largest music education conference in the world with over 17,000 participants last year
- Invitation is by a lengthy audition process involving video performances, audio recordings, letters of recommendation from prominent educators, photos and essays
- In 71 years, only 15 groups from Arizona have ever been invited (ALL from the Phoenix area)
- We will be only the 3rd jazz group from all of Arizona to be invited
